LEGISLATOR VOTING RECORDS, VOTER REGISTRATION
AND NEW BALLOT MATERIAL**

As part of a newly established NJFC Grassroots effort known as the NJ Prosperity Project, members and their associates can engage employees and consumers on public policy issues and motivate them to exercise their right to vote. We wholeheartedly encourage every member to utilize this web based program to expose the food business community, associates and family members to issues important to their jobs and business prosperity.

With that in mind, NJFC reminds members that the voter registration deadline is next **Tuesday October 13, 2009**. This is a very important deadline and members are encouraged to remind associates to register to vote.

Also new this year in New Jersey, any voter can vote by mail in any election. *You do not need a reason to Vote by Mail.* Applications for vote by mail can be found at our new www.njprosperity.org website or the NJ State Department website www.state.nj.us/state/elections/mail-in_doe.html.

A voter may vote by mail by completing the **Application for Vote by Mail Ballot** and mailing the application to their County Clerk up to 7 days prior to the election. A voter may also apply in person to the County Clerk until 3:00 p.m., the day before the election.

You can also find the voting records of candidates in any given NJ legislative district by going to the NJFC inspired www.njprosperity.org website.

We strongly urge you to make every voice in the food industry heard on Election Day so please forward this email onto your associates so they can become involved and engaged in the democratic process.
